

# Five Positions of the Major/Minor Pentatonic Scale on the Guitar

The following diagrams represent the five positions of the A minor or C major pentatonic scale and use the notes C, D, E, G, and A over the neck of the guitar. By starting the positions on the first note of any minor pentatonic scale and tracing the notes of that scale across the low E string, these five positions can be applied to any minor or major pentatonic scale.
